

Research report: Data security confidence index

Four in five (80%) ITDM respondents believe that their organisation was impacted as a result of the GDPR being introduced in May this 2018.

Although worryingly, around four in five (82%) surveyed ITDMs state that their organisation finds it difficult to remain compliant with the data regulations that it must abide by.

The majority (79%) of ITDM respondents state that their organization has faced challenges in addressing the GDPR, with the deadline (37%) and/or not being a senior executive priority (29%) being the most common.



Fewer than three in five (57%) ITDM respondents report that all of their organisation's sensitive data is secure.

68% of IT professionals believe their organisations are failing to carry out all procedures in line with data protection laws.

68% of IT professionals believe unauthorised users can access their networks.
